Residential Wiring

- Official SkillsUSA uniform as describe below

For men: Official red blazer, black slacks with white dress shirt, plain black tie with no pattern or official SkillsUSA black tie, black socks and black shoes.

For women: Official red blazer, black skirt or slacks with businesslike white, collarless blouse or white blouse with small, plain collar that may not extend onto the lapels of the blazer, black sheer or skin-tone seamless hose and black dress shoes. **Note:** T-shirt-style tops are not approved.

Equipment Contestants Bring:

Contestants should bring a pencil, hand or power tools (includes a drill and auger bit), ½ EMT bender, a 2008 NEC book, and other equipment necessary to complete a residential wiring skills problem.

Equipment Provided:

Major equipment necessary to complete the skills portion of the contest will be provided, such as the room modules, wire, boxes, etc.

Contest Rules

Judges are sole authorities that determine content and procedural violations.

No advisors, instructors, or observers will be allowed in the contest area.

Scope of the Contest

The contest will assess the ability to perform jobs or skills selected from competencies listed from the national residential wiring regulations.

Skills Performance

The skills portion of the contest will include a series of work stations that have information and instruction sheets for wiring a particular room in residential.

All work must conform to the specifications of the latest edition of the National Electrical Code as of the January prior to the SkillsUSA Championships.

Technical Scoring and Standards

Judging is based on following point system:

- 80 Points Safety
- 70 Points NEC
- 112 Points Height Requirements
- 112 Points Device Locations
- 100 Points Wiring Methods
- 70 Points Grounding, Splices and Termination
- 40 Points Overall neatness
- 70 Points Function/Operation Test
- 84 Points Box Locations
- 42 Points Contestant Interview
- 70 Points EMT – Pipe Bending
- 150 Points Written Test

Total points: 1,000

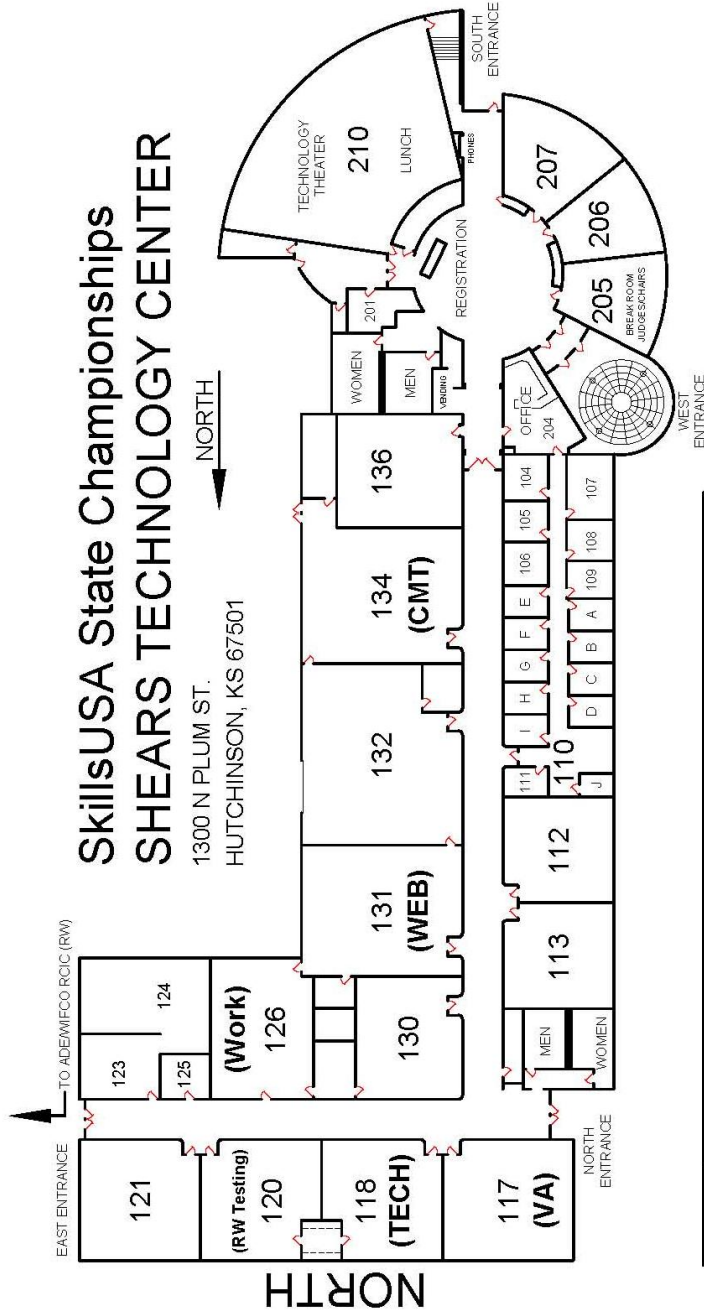

Directions to Campus

From U.S. 50 - Turn North on K-61. Turn left on 11th Avenue. Turn right on Plum Street and then right on 14th Street. Main parking lot is located 1/2 block East of Plum on right side or park at any HCC lot noted above.

From K-61 - Turn West on 11th Avenue to Plum Street. Turn right on Plum Street, go North to 14th Street and turn right. Main parking lot is located 1/2 block East of Plum on right side or park at any HCC lot noted above.

From K-96 - Continue through South Hutchinson and exit on Avenue A. Go Avenue A, 4th Street and turn left. Go North to 14th Street and turn right. Proceed to Plum Street. Main parking lot is located 1/2 block East of Plum on right side or park at any HCC lot noted above.

From Airport Road - Go West on 17th Avenue to Plum Street, turn left (South) to 14th Street, turn left again East. Main parking lot is located 1/2 block East of Plum on right side or park at any HCC lot noted above.

Entering from the West side of Hutchinson - Travel East on Avenue A, 4th Street, or 11th Street turn left (North) on Plum Street. Continue North to 14th & Plum turn right (East). Main parking lot is located 1/2 block East of Plum on right side or park at any HCC lot noted above.
